STEPS FOR PRESCHOOL AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT TEACHERS IN GERMANY

Finding a Job: Teacher candidates who apply to our organization receive detailed information about the process from our professional consultants. They can also begin their German language education at our courses in Istanbul and Ankara, affiliated with the Ministry of National Education.

Equivalency Procedures: Our consultants assist in preparing, translating, and notarizing the documents needed for professional equivalence applications.

Visa Application Assistance: For teachers whose professional recognition procedures are completed, we facilitate the application for an 81A visa, also known as a fast-track visa, allowing them to travel to Germany once the application process is completed.
